


INTRODUCTION



EAT AND DRINK WHAT IS GOOD FOR YOUR BODY

- "Wherefore do ye spend money for that which is not bread? And your labour for that which satisfieth not? Hearken diligently unto me, and eat ye that which is good, And let your soul delight itself in fatness." - <u>Isaiah 55:2</u>
- "Whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God" <u>1 Corinthians</u> <u>10:31</u>

- "As he thinks in his heart, so is he" <u>Proverbs 23:7</u>




DEVELOP A TRUST IN GOD


BALANCE WORKING, EXERCISING AND SLEEPING


AVOID DRINKING ALCOHOL

- "Wine *is* a mocker, strong drink *is* raging: And whosoever is deceived thereby is not wise." <u>Proverbs</u> 20:1
- "Look not thou upon the wine when it is red, When it giveth his colour in the cup, *When* it moveth itself aright. At the last it biteth like a serpent, And stingeth like an adder." <u>Proverbs 23:31-32</u>
- Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind, Nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom of God" 1 Corinthians 6:9-10.



AVOID ADDICTIVE SUBSTANCES (TABACCO,...)

- "Then saith Jesus unto him, Get thee hence, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve" <u>Matthew 4:10</u>
- "Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean *thing*; and I will receive you" <u>2 Corinthians 6:17</u>
- "Wherefore do ye spend money for *that which is* not bread? And your labour for *that which* satisfieth not. Hearken diligently unto me, and eat ye *that which is* good, And let your soul delight itself in fatness." Isaiah 55:2

- "And also that every man should eat and drink, and enjoy the good of all his labour, it *is* the gift of God." - <u>Ecclesiastes 3:13</u>




HELP THE NEEDY






GOD LOVES YOU




Please note
